

- ▼ Ten Minute Mac episode 10 - Friday, Oct. 13 2006
 - No site news
- ▼ The news is interesting, so instead of jumping right into Remote Administration, we're going to go into news
 - New Apple logo at 5th street store; Red
 - New red iPod nano; funds go to Bono's AIDS-awareness charity, RED
- ▼ 3 new Mac ads
 - ▼ Gizelle, supermodel makes network television debut
 - I saw these ads at the Apple Store about a month and a half ago
 - ▼ StarBucks invades the iTunes store
 - They've launched their own mini-store with tracks played inside their cafes
 - ▼ Engadget reports that the "true" video iPod will have wifi, big screen and a release date set before the end of the year
 - I've heard too many of these to feel anywhere near excited about it
- ▼ iPod screen saver
 - Make a new folder in root directory called "Demo Mode"
 - use iTunes 7 to pull an iPod compatible video and name it "Demo"
 - eject the iPod, but leave it plugged in
 - Wait about 2 minutes and the video will start playing like a screensaver
 - Be careful with this. This hack will reset all of your menu items, so if you customized, make sure you take note of their placement.
 - Just in case there was any confusion, this only works on 5 and 5.5 gen iPods
- ▼ Apple has released a new pre-release edition of Leopard to developers
 - The build is 9A283e
 - Apparently there are still a lot of bugs, but it is coming along at a relatively swift pace
 - Reported "significant updates to the iCal and Preview applications, such as new interfaces and editing tools, respectively
